AND NOW, this 23rd day of March, 2020, it is hereby ORDERED that pursuant to the General Statewide Judicial Emergency Order issued by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court on March 18, 2020, Temporary and Final proceedings under the Protection From Abuse Act are considered essential services and will continue to be heard. To protect the health, safety and welfare of the public as well as court and county employees, attendance at these proceedings shall be limited to the parties and counsel who have entered their appearance to represent them.

Requests to participate in the proceedings by use of expanded communication technology such as telephone or video will be considered at the time of the Final Hearing. Determinations will be made by the assigned Judge on a case-by-case basis.
